Workforce Australia – Transition to Work is for young people (aged 15 - 24) who are no longer at school and looking for their next step to get work or further education to reach their goals.

Disability Employment Services is an Australian Government initiative to help people with an injury, illness or disability find and keep a job. Through this program, we work with job seekers and local employers to achieve life-changing outcomes and tailor-made recruitment solutions.
